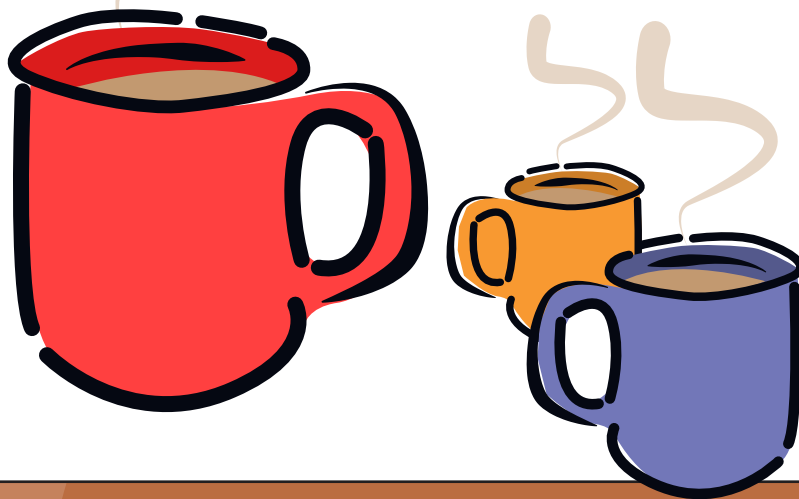

5th March - **Wolverton**. Turn into Wolverton Road at Badgers Wood Baughurst. Playground car park on the right after 2.5 miles.

2nd April - **Brimpton Common**. Park on verge opposite "La Capanna" (previously the Pineapple)

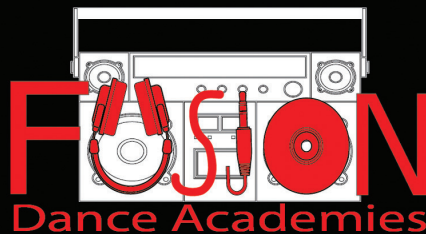
